Former SA Burbank began her career with the FBI in 2005. Following her graduation from Quantico, she was assigned to the Cleveland Field Office, where she served in both White Collar Crime and Counterintelligence. Additionally, she was trained by the FBI's Crisis Negotiation Unit, distinguishing herself as one of the Bureau's youngest hostage negotiators.

Prior to Ms. Burbank's entry to the Bureau, she spent two years as an ADA at the Manhattan District Attorney's office, having graduated at the top of her class from New York University Law School. She received her BS in Crime, Law, and Justice from Penn State. Recruited by the FBI for the select Honors Internship Program, Ms. Burbank is fluent in Spanish, French, Italian, Greek, Arabic, Farsi, and Mandarin. In addition to her career and academic achievements, she is a certified instructor of Krav Maga, the hand-to-hand combat fighting system deployed by the Israeli Defense Force.

Due to a life-threatening injury sustained in the line of duty, Ms. Burbank left the Bureau to rehabilitate. Currently, she works as an independent consultant training law enforcement and private organizations in crisis resolution. A native New Yorker, Ms. Burbank now resides in New Jersey.
